

Chain of Responsibility Policy Standard

CV Services recognises its duty as an employer to ensure the health and safety at work of all team members, stakeholders and contractors and always puts safety first in everything we do. This compliance policy provides a framework to ensure that CV Services and its workers cooperate to ensure that compliance with chain of responsibility obligations are met.

CV Services, to the extent we are reasonably able to do so, will maintain effective Chain of Responsibility policies and procedures. Our Chain of Responsibility compliance programs will:

- ensure all parties within the CV Services supply chain; including workers and suppliers, are not encouraged or required to breach NHVL Chain of Responsibility Legislation to complete a task;
- implement systems and processes to achieve compliance with the Chain of Responsibility laws;
- take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Chain of Responsibility systems are maintained, including implementing adequate supervision and auditing the systems;
- appoint a Chain of Responsibility Compliance Officer to monitor this policy; and
- implement a Chain of Responsibility training program.
- implement structured hazard identification and risk management processes for supply and transport operations;
- consult with, communicate, and train our employees and stakeholders so they are aware of their obligations for Chain of Responsibility standards and ensure that safe work practices are undertaken;
- ensure heavy vehicle transport drivers do not speed or drive fatigued for CV Services

Compliance will be rigorously driven through clearly established incident reporting and investigation procedures and the carrying out of regular compliance audits.

CV Services will always seek to improve our Chain of Responsibility performance and are committed to a process of continuous improvement through regular reporting, structured reviews, effective consultation and industry benchmarking. At all times we are driven by our safety vision of “a totally healthy workforce with zero injuries”.

CV Services believes that the health and safety of all team members is the responsibility of all levels of management. Our people are also expected to accept appropriate levels of responsibility for their own health and safety as well as that of their colleagues and others.
