

Obligations under the Qld Electrical Safety Act and Regulations

CV Services management will fulfil their obligations under the Electrical Safety Act and Electrical Safety Regulation by:

- Developing operational procedures and providing training to team members to ensure that all electrical work complies with requirements and is electrically safe;
- Ensuring that all electrical equipment, tools and safety equipment is regularly tested/examined to enable all electrical work to be completed in a safe manner; and
- Instructing team members in the correct use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and other equipment so that everyone has the knowledge to undertake electrical work safely and ensure a safe workplace for others.

CV Services team members will fulfil their obligations under the Electrical Safety Act and Electrical Safety Regulation by:

- Complying with company instructions and ensuring that all electrical work is undertaken safely and is safe when completed;
- Using PPE, instruments, tools and safety equipment to complete all electrical work in a safe manner and in compliance with legislative requirements; and
- Not wilfully, or negligently, interfering or misusing anything that may create an unsafe situation for themselves or others.

All team members must adopt a “test before touch” approach and treat all conductors and equipment as live until proven otherwise.

All electrical incidents or dangerous events will be reported and investigated in accordance with the **CV Services** Incident Reporting and Investigation Procedure.
